- STAT fee: please contact lab in advance to arrange scheduling and fees.
- Before*** submitting fresh brain tissue for rabies testing, call your local health department. Rabies specimens are tested by the Washington State Department of Health: Washington Public Health Laboratories, Attn: Virology, 1610 NE 150th Street, Shoreline, WA 98155-9701, 206-418- 5458. Samples for rabies testing as part of a complete neurological disease workup will be forwarded to the Washington Public Health Laboratories by WADDL.
- Specimens submitted for examination may undergo additional diagnostic testing for state or federal disease surveillance programs, particularly involving foreign animal diseases.
